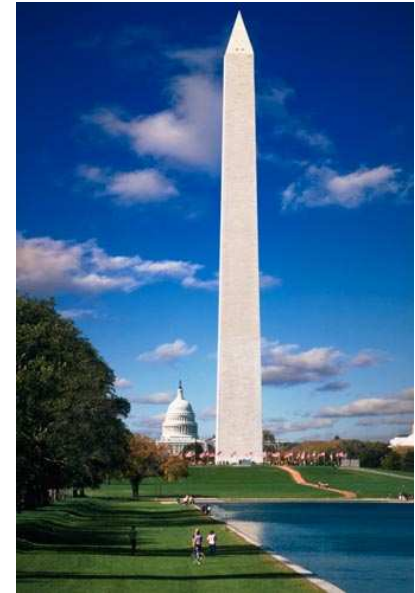




The White House is in Washington D.C. It is the home of the President of the United States. It is also the place where the president works.
